



## **MAUK & KCA- To Organise Joint Family Funday**

Two leading Malayalee organisations in the UK – Malayalee Association of the UK (MAUK) and Kerala Catholic Association (KCA) have agreed to jointly organise the Annual Family Funday. This will be one of the biggest outdoor events organised by any Malayalee Organisation.

The Executive Committee of KCA and the Board of Directors of MAUK met at Kerala House (Manor Park) on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> Feb to discuss the details of this historic agreement. The Meeting was also an opportunity for both the organisations office bearers to meet each other.
